



Organic Apple Orchard Seeking Part-time Workers in June

This is a short-term outdoor job with flexible hours. The ideal candidate will work at least 10-21 hours per week. Work can be scheduled around other jobs or commitments – see below. Pay is \$15+ per hour.

Task: You will thin apples (pick off small, unneeded fruits from the trees). This is tedious and repetitive. You need to be focused and efficient.

Work setting: Work outside with the orchard owners and other employees. Enjoy a positive, enthusiastic atmosphere. We maintain a respectful, safe, and polite workplace.

Qualifications: No experience is required. We will train you. Here's what you need to do:

- Work carefully. *We're doing important work that needs to be done well.*
- Work quickly. *We have a lot to get done, and you need to set a good pace.*
- Cooperate and communicate with co-workers. *Don't wear earbuds.*
- Follow instructions and show a positive attitude.
- Work outside, including in hot weather.
- Bend, stoop, and kneel. Work from a ladder (less than six feet high).

Dates: Approximately June 1-19, 2026 (exact dates depend on weather).

Schedule: We need to schedule thinning around weather and other orchard work. We will use the Sling app to schedule shifts. We'll announce shifts as they become available, generally several days in advance, and you can sign yourself up to work. Shift times will generally be mornings (8:30 am-Noon) and afternoons (1:00 pm- 4:30 pm) Monday-Saturday. (Saturday shifts are not usual.) We hope to have 6-8 of these half-day shifts available each week. You must work full shifts – no starting late or leaving early, with limited exceptions. We may occasionally need to cancel a shift last-minute because of unexpected weather.

Pay: \$15+ per hour based on experience. We may provide in-season raises. If you work 6-8 shifts in total, we will pay you a \$50 bonus at the end of June. If you work 9+ shifts, the bonus is \$100.

Age requirements: According to Wisconsin law, you must be at least age 12 to work on our farm. No work permits are required for minors doing farm work. To comply with state law, employees aged 12-15 will be limited to a single shift (3.5 hours) per day and 5 shifts per week.
